SHORT TERM VOCATIONAL TRAINING COURSE

ON

CONSTRUCTION SUPERVISOR

The course is designed and structured for the unemployed youths who passed Madhyamik and also for those who are working in construction Industry but their skill is not tested and certified. The student, on completion of the course, may seek employment in construction firms or start practising as construction supervisor or labour contractor.

The course contains theoretical lessons on building construction starting from foundation to finishing including construction survey, material selection, estimating, tendering, site management, drawing and practical lessons on supervision with site visits. The course is taught in Bengali by the highly qualified and experienced professionals drawn from govt. and private sector.

Session: From Jan to June and from July to Dec every year.

Class:

- (i) 2 hrs daily from 3.30 PM to 5.30 PM four days a week for unemployed youths.
- (ii) 2 hrs daily from 6.30 PM to 8.30 PM four days a week for working persons.
- (iii) 6 hrs from 10.00 AM to 6.30 PM with $\frac{1}{2}$ hr. recess, one day a week, for persons attending classes from distant places outside Kolkata.

Examination Fee: Rs. 100/- or as may be fixed from time to time by the West Bengal State Council of Technical Education to be paid at the time of filling the form for examination.

Seats: 30 on first come first serve basis.

DIPLOMA IN SAFETY ENGINEERING

The Course is designed and structured for employed and unemployed youths with B. Sc. degree. The unemployed after completion of the diploma find employment as Safety Officers, a statutory requirement for organisations engaged in engineering activities like manufacturing, construction.

Classes are held on Wednesdays & Thursdays or Saturdays and Sundays. Hours are flexible to the mutual convenience of the students and the teachers.

Examination Fee: As stipulated by WBSC TE

Seats: 20 maximum on first come first serve basis.
