A question has arisen whether we want Mind or Machine or Mind and Machine. The question of mind brings the man in the forefront. Man consists not only of a body and brain, but of equally tangible things like feelings, fears, hopes etc as the man is a "whole being". Body and mind are not separate entities and human knowledge, however varied it may be, cannot be completely divorced from one another. Scientific and metaphysical conceptions, however, are yet distinct though at the summit there is no distinction. A scientist proves the existence of Creator by analysing the creations. While no amount of achievement in other spheres can contribute to property and security without engineering progress, Engineering by itself provides; no security for individual, social and economical ills. Engineering can perfect the machine but not the mind. A single installed horsepower is equivalent to about ten man-hours. Engineering can harness material resources and transfrom into mechanical energy to save human labour and time, so that more leisure is available to workers for recreation of mind. But how the mind recreates? Is it by seeing televisions or raising the vision to a higher plane to see the Source of all energy?
