Visit to The National Iron & Steel Works, Belur

The Association of Engineers had the pleasure of a visit to the workshops of the N. I. S. Co., at Belur, on Saturday, 13th March, 1943. Members of the Association were met by representatives of the firm at the entrance gate of the workshops and courteously shown round the several departments, the Electric Furnace, the new open hearth Furnace under construction, the Rolling Mill, the newly Extended Machine Shop, the Bolt and Nut Factory its proposed extension, Wire drawing section and finally the Screw Factory, after which they were treated to a delightful fare of light refreshments.

The impression gained from the visit was that Industrial enterprise of an extremely high standard was in a state of satisfactory progress that deserved the highest success.

It was a wonderfully pleasing sight to see the assembly of rolls, millstands and other auxiliaries cast and manufactured on the site by Indians. The smooth clock like progress of work without evidence of goading of the human factor by harsh language from any foreman and the complete absence of need of any foreign element for quickening of production was most edifying. The manufacture of machines locally for increase of mill production is highly commendable, and shows the capability of the firm for expansion.

Production is now limited to Bars and Rods. But it may be that the future will see the expansion of production to include sheets, plates angles channels, joists, and sections suitable for the heaviest structural work.
