- c) Educational deficiencies to be removed urgently. Suitable administrative and consultative bodies to be constituted to foster discipline,
- d) No polarisation between teachers, students and administrators in the whole university life,
- e) Augmentation of employment potential for engineers
- f) Broad based educational policies keeping in view the country's requireements and the avenues of employment available,
- g) Provision of guidance counselling and a bureau of career and guidance/training and placement service and

h) Involving the students in the administration of academic affairs.

The steps mentioned above indicate the broad outlines on which an institution may function and how technical education is to be planned in order to stop student unrest and to improve academic standards. Such an institution bids fair to produce really potential administrators, engineers, teachers, scientists and technologists for the country. The need for well-planned, vigorous and sustained action requires no emphasis. A student is a sacred trust. He is the future hope of the country. He must be helped to acquit himself well in life.
