

Spinifex texture in Serpentinite from Karnataka

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Attention is invited to the paper entitled 'Possible Spinifex texture in a Serpentinite from Karnataka' by M. N. Viswanatha, M. Ramakrishnan and T. R. Narayanan Kutty published in the Journal Vol. 18, No. 4, April 1977, pp. 194 to 197. The area was revisited and a few photos taken bringing out the undoubted nature of the spinifex texture. Since this rare texture in the Karnataka craton has aroused the interests of active geoscientists working on the early precambrian granite-greenstone terrains, one of the photos showing the typical spinifex texture is being published. The locality is from the prominent ridge about 2 km South of Kummanghatta ($13^{\circ}59' : 76^{\circ}18'$; 57 C/5), east of the Janakal-Talya road.
