Annual General Meeting – 2006

and

National Seminar on Active and Fossil Suture Zones

The Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Geological Society of India for 2006 will be held at Dehradun, at the invitation of the Wadia Institute of Himalayan Geology, Dehradun during 22-24 November, 2006. A National Seminar on “Active and Fossil Suture Zones” will be held concurrently, organized by the Wadia Institute of Himalayan Geology, Dehradun. There will also be a short field trip to Mussoorie Section on 25 November, 2006.

The Seminar will cover the following major themes:

- Tectonic Framework and Crustal Evolution of Suture Zones in the Indian Subcontinent – Structure/Magmatism/Metamorphism/Metallogeny/Sub-surface signatures
- Indus-Tsangpo Suture Zone and overlying Plutonic belts of the Himalaya – Structural Framework/Magmatism/Metamorphism/Geochronology/Geophysical signatures
- Signatures of Collision Tectonics in the Indian Craton and Himalaya – Development of Fold and Thrust Belts – Collision related granite production and Metamorphism
- Sedimentation *vis-à-vis* Tectonics of the major sedimentary basins of Indian Craton and Himalaya
- Sunda-Andaman Arc – Processes of Subduction, Magmatism, Seismicity and Active Tectonics.
