geological profession of this country. More importantly, however, he will be cherished for his sterling human qualities, his total dedication to work even under trying circumstances and his catholicity of outlook.

In remembering and celebrating the centenary of John Bicknell Auden, the Geological Society of India has paid homage to a great geologist, a person who loved India and its culture and a humanist *par excellence* worthy of emulation by the younger generation.
