SERC SUMMER SCHOOL IN GEOLOGICAL MAPPING OF PROTEROZOIC FOLD BELT OF ZAWAR AREA, UDAIPUR DISTRICT, RAJASTHAN (DST PROGRAMME)

Geological Survey of India (GSI) Training Institute will conduct a Training course on Geological Mapping of Proterozoic Fold Belt of Zawar Area, Udaipur District, Rajasthan, at Zawar under Second 5-year Cycle of SERC Summer/Winter School Mapping sponsored by the Department of Science and Technology (DST), Government of India. The course is for a duration of four weeks beginning in November, 2001. It will be essentially a field training with theoretical lectures. The faculty for the course will be experienced and eminent scientists from the GSI and Universities. The course is open to young Research Scholars/Lecturers from Universities/Colleges and professional geologists from Central and States organizations/Institutions who are interested in geological mapping of such terrains. Candidates should be below 35 years of age. There is no course fee and T.A./D.A. will be paid by the DST as per the rules applicable.
