The volume has been produced well, excepting for the need to make some minor editorial corrections. For each reference, the papers would have been organized under broad titles mentioned by the editors themselves on the last cover. Considering the regional coverage of the volume, a title mentioning the region would have been more appropriate. The author index given at the end of the volume is useful. A subject index would have added to greater usability of the volume. The diagrams are in general drafted well and the printing is good. However, the photographs on reproduction

have lost their clarity in most cases. The preface written by the lead editor is appropriate and sets the right tone for the volume. The cost of the book is unfortunately on the higher side. It is a landmark publication on the Quaternary research of the region. The book is a valuable asset for the student, coastal researcher and the management community in general.
