

A NEW VARIETY OF *JASMINUM MULTIFLORUM*  
(Burm. f.) ANDR. FROM THE NICOBAR ISLANDS

A B S T R A C T

*Jasminum multiflorum* (Burm. f.) Andr. var. *nicobaricum* Thoth. var. nov., collected from the Car Nicobar Island is described.

***Jasminum multiflorum* (Burm. f.) Andr. var. *nicobaricum* Thoth. var. nov.**

Accedit ad *J. multiflorum* Andr. f. *acuminatissimum* (Bl.) Bakh. f. (= *acuminatissimum* Bl.) multis in notis, ab eodem tamen differt foliis largioribus (6.5–15.8 × 3.2–8.0 cm.), petiolis longioribus (0.7–2.0 cm.), calycis tubo fere glabro et longiore corolla (2.2–3.8 cm.).

*Frutex* volubilis; culmi teretes, glabri, virgultis inconspicue striatis; nodi aeque ac foliorum, axillae puberuli. *Folia* simplicia, alterna, petiolata, exstipulata, ex ovatis ovato-oblonga, 6.5–15.8 cm. longa, 3.2–8.0 cm. lata, integra, ad apicem cuspidata, retusa ad basin, glabra, subcoriacea; nervis laterali bus 7-9-jugibus ad margines arcuatis, eminentioribus in pagina inferiore; petioli articulati dimidio infra medium, 0.7–2.0 cm. longi, canaliculati et puberuli supra. *Inflorescentia* axillaris et terminalis, trichotome cymosa, 4.7–9.0 cm. longa. *Flores* fragrantes, 3.0–3.8 cm. longi, bracteati, pediculis 3.0–6.0 mm. longis, bracteis eminentibus, linearibus, 0.4–1.5 cm. longis, margine interiore paulum puberulo. *Calycis tubus* 6.0–9.0 mm. longus dentibus inclusis, glaber infra, sparse puberulus supra, dentibus 6, eminentibus, puberulis, tubo paulo longioribus. *Corolla* alba, tubo erecto, lobis 7–8 patentibus, imbricatis, 2.2–3.8 cm. longis. *Stamina* 2, epipetala, filamentis brevibus insidentia ad medium corollae tubum infixis; antherae oblongae, basifixae, connectivo in appendicem mucronatum desinente. *Ovarium* globosum, bilobulare, ovulis binis in singulis loculis; stylus longus, tenuis; stigma bifidum, triangulare. *Fructus* ignotus.

Type *Thothathri* 9345A, isotypi *Thothathri* 9345 B-F, lecti ad Malacca in Insula Car Nicobar die 30 mensis martii anni 1959 et positi in herbario calcuttensi.

***Jasminum multiflorum* (Burm. f.) Andr. var. *nicobaricum* Thoth. var. nov.** is close to *J. multi-*

*florum* (Burm. f.) Andr. form. *acuminatissimum* (Bl.) Bakh. f. (*J. acuminatissimum* Bl.) but differing from the latter in having larger leaves (6.5–15.8 cm. long, 3.2–8.0 cm. wide), longer petiole (0.7–2.0 cm. long), nearly glabrous calyx tube and longer corolla (2.2–3.8 cm. long).

A climbing shrub. Stem terete, glabrous; young shoots faintly striated; nodes and axils of leaves puberulous. Leaves simple, alternate, petiolate, exstipulate, ovate to ovate-oblong, 6.5–15.8 cm. long, 3.2–8.0 cm. wide, entire, cuspidate at apex, retuse at base, glabrous, subcoriaceous; lateral nerves 7-9 pairs, looping at margin, more prominent on the abaxial side; petiole being articulated half below the middle, 0.7–2.0 cm. long, grooved and puberulous above. Inflorescence axillary and terminal trichotomous cymes, 4.7–9.0 cm. long. Flowers fragrant, 3.0–3.8 cm. long, bracteate; pedicels 3.0–6.0 mm. long; bracts prominent, linear, 0.4–1.5 cm. long, inner margin slightly puberulous. Calyx tube 6.0–9.0 mm. long including the teeth, glabrous below, sparsely puberulous above; teeth 6, prominent, puberulous, slightly longer than the tube. Corolla white, tube erect, lobes 7–8, spreading, imbricate, 2.2–3.8 cm. long. Stamens 2, epipetalous, filaments short, situated just in the middle of the corolla tube; anthers oblong, basifixed, connective appendaged above into a mucro. Ovary globose, 2 celled with 2 ovules in each cell; style long, slender; stigma bifid, triangular. Fruit not known.

Distribution: Car Nicobar Island, Nicobars.

Type: Malacca, Car Nicobar Island, 30-3-1959—*Thothathri* 9345-A, Holotype; 9345 B-F, Isotypes (Herb. CAL).


