Obituary

Professor Abdul Quadir (Chairman, Department of Anaesthesiology, Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College, AMU, Aligarh) passed away on 3rd February, 2018 after a prolonged illness, at the age of 56 years.

A native of Bihar, Prof. Quadir graduated from Patna Medical College prior to getting admission in MD Anaesthesiology in 1989. He began his career as senior resident and subsequently joined as lecture in the department of Anaesthesiology, J.N. Medical College, AMU, Aligarh. He was promoted as professor in 2007.

As an academic, Prof. Quadir's thrust area was oxygen therapy and he was also known for his interests in airways, clinical pharmacology of anaesthetic drugs, resuscitation and pharmacovigilance. He had numerous publications in journals of national and international repute to his credit and had supervised over 15 research scholars. Prof. Quadir will forever be remembered for his simplicity and unique style of teaching.

The deceased is survived by wife and two sons, Zulqarnain and Quratulain, who reside in Sir Syed Nagar area in Aligarh.
